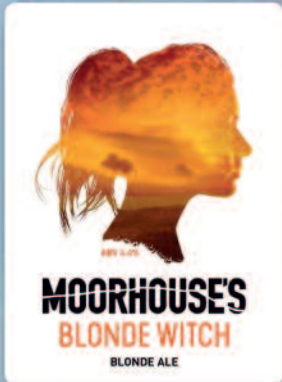

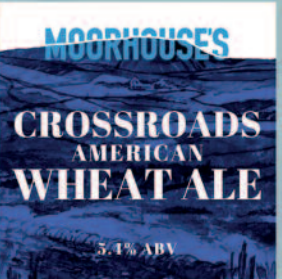

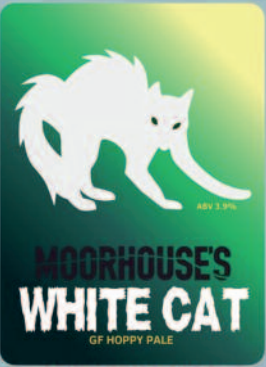

Mobberley Brewhouse, Cheshire

Situated in an idyllic location in a small village in Cheshire, Mobberley produce a growing range of craft beers. Inspiration for their beers is drawn from the sprawling countryside that surrounds the brewery.

1 Best 4% BI ♦

A well rounded, premium best bitter with a perfect balance of malt sweetness and hop bitterness. Smooth, rich, and satisfying with a lingering depth of flavour.

2 Hedgehopper 3.8% PA ♦

Brewed to celebrate 150 years of Mobberley Fine Ales. A brilliant example of a traditional golden ale. Deep & rich malty overtones with a subtle hint of hops.

3 Heritage IPA 5.2% IPA ♦

A traditional English IPA brewed in a classic heritage style. Deep golden to light amber in colour, with aromas of caramel malt, toasted biscuit and subtle earthy hops. The palate is smooth and balanced, delivering rich malt sweetness upfront before giving way to a firm, drying bitterness. Notes of toffee, bread crust and gentle spice are complemented by hints of smoky character and a clean, satisfying finish.

4 Heritage Robust Porter 5% ST/PO ♦

A classic robust porter with rich notes of dark chocolate, coffee and roasted malt. Smooth and full-bodied, with a gentle bitterness and a dry, satisfying finish.

5 IPA 5.2% IPA ♦

An easy drinking, clear, crisp & clean IPA. Big hops balance against a malty backbone, creating a beer with serious drinkability.

6 Pale 4% PA ♦

A classic pale ale, brewed with traditional malt & hops for a timeless drinking experience. Light and easy drinking with subtle malt undertones, with a clean and smooth finish.

7 Stout 4.5% ST/PO ♦

Dark, smooth, and velvety with roasted malt flavours that provide a balanced, full-bodied experience. Clean finish with a touch of sweetness.



Moorhouse's Brewery, Burnley

Moorhouse's is an independent brewery founded in 1865, starting life as a producer of mineral waters and low-alcohol beers known as hop bitters. [2] It first produced cask ales in 1978. At the heart of what Moorhouse's do is their state of the art brewery which combines their brewers' craft with the innovation and new techniques of today.

8 Blonde Witch 4.4% PA ♦

A punchy, full-bodied blonde ale with a distinct fruit taste and citrus hop finish. Blonde Witch was awarded a Diploma in its category (ale 4.0% – 4.5%) from the British Bottlers Institute Drinks Competition in 2025.

9 Cross Roads 5.4% SP ♦

Bold, hazy and full of character, this modern wheat ale combines a soft, pillowy wheat body with vibrant hop character. Amarillo and First Gold hops deliver notes of orange blossom, marmalade and gentle spice, leading to a clean finish with hints of citrus and floral bitterness.

10 Pendle Witches Brew 5.1% BI ♦

A bold, malty amber beer with spiced fruit notes and a crisp, fruity aftertaste.

11 Sun Worshipper 4.5% PA ♦

Extra pale session ale dry hopped with Nelson Sauvin and Charles Faram T45 Olicana hops to give summer aromas of Gooseberries, Mango's and Passionfruit.

12 White Cat 3.9% PA ♦

A mischievously bright gluten free pale ale brewed with Citra and Amarillo. Juicy tropical hits from Citra meet zesty sweet orange and floral notes from Amarillo, creating a crisp, fruit-forward beer that purrs with citrus charm. Light in strength, bold in character.

13 Witch Hunt 4.8% BI ♦

A well-rounded amber ale balancing rich malts and spiced fruit complexity with a satisfyingly crisp, fruity aftertaste.

14 Witches' Cauldron 4.2% BI ♦

An amber coloured ale, rich in malt, with a fruity body and a strong hop aftertaste.

Strawberry Fields, Liverpool

Relatively new on the scene, Strawberry Fields Brewery was borne out of true love for the golden, magical drink. Their exceptionally tasty craft beers are locally produced and you may recognise a few of their beer names too. Brewed in the same premises as their sister brewery, Big Bog.



15 Kaleidoscope 5.3% PA ♦

A hop-forward IPA showcasing generous additions of Mosaic hops throughout the brewing process. Bursting with tropical fruit flavours of mango and passionfruit, these vibrant hop characters are balanced by a base of pale ale malt and a touch of torrefied wheat, creating a robust, full-bodied beer with a crisp, refreshing finish.

Brew York Brewery, York

Brew York was born out of two friends' passion for beer and brewing. The brewery consists of a 20 HL brewhouse and over 260 HL in fermenting and conditioning capacity. A very unique taproom with riverside beer garden has been constructed right alongside the brewhouse to showcase the beers at their freshest.



16 Citrus Cinema 4.5% SP ♦

Brewed in collaboration with OSO Brew Co. — an orange and lemon fruited pale ale inspired by iconic Spanish film director and screenwriter Pedro Almodóvar. Bursting with bright citrus character, Citrus Cinema delivers layers of juicy orange, sharp lemon zest, and a crisp, refreshing finish worthy of the big screen.

17 Minstermen Pride 4.1% PA ♦

Dan's been waiting for an excuse to put this beer on at one of our festivals for a long time, and what better time than York City's title-winning season! Light, citrus-forward American pale ale. Crisp with mild malt notes and full of juicy hops. Please note - for every beer sold Dan's smile gets a little bigger.

18 Poisoned Chalice 3.9% BI ♦

Brewed in collaboration with York Minster to mark the 800th anniversary of Saint William of York, and inspired by the legend of St William's alleged poisoning from a chalice during Mass. Crisp, well-balanced best bitter with toasty malt, gentle caramel sweetness and Brew York's trademark hoppy character.

Colbier Brew Co, Liverpool

Established in 2024 by Mike Corbett, Stuart Rumble and Vik Williams, who, collectively carry over a decade of experience gleaned from their respective roles in various local craft beer bars and breweries.

Forging a bond through their shared passion for music, they embrace a philosophy that mirrors musicology - to



acknowledge rules while daring to break them. Equalising balance, simplicity, and quality, they are producing the very styles that ignited their brewing journey. Experimenting on a pilot kit and fine-tuning core recipes on a larger 20HL kit, to consistently deliver Proper Sound Beers from the beat of Liverpool.

19 Flexatone 4.8% PA ♦

Double dry-hopped Spring pale ale. Flexatone is the ideal sunshine beer. Motueka and Azacca in abundance bring glorious melon and dry citrus flavours, while NEIPA yeast makes for an effortlessly smooth finish.

20 Skirl 5% IPA ♦

A collaboration brew with Edinburgh's Barney's Beer, this malt-forward IPA combines heritage and Scottish malts with a traditional Scottish yeast strain. Expect bold pine, resin and grassy hop character, balanced by a solid malt backbone, with Zappa, Chinook, Cascade, Cashmere and Columbus hops delivering a robust, bitter finish.

Goffs Brewery,

Winchcombe, Gloucestershire

Goffs Brewery was founded in Winchcombe by Marcus and Alison Goff, with the aim of establishing a family concern, using closely-guarded traditional recipes. Demand for Goffs' ales has grown, and they are now available in pubs, inns and hotels throughout the West Country.



21 Pan Asian Pale 4.1% SP ♦

Something a little bit different, this one. Light and refreshing rice beer brewed with Citra hops and infused with yuzu fruit for a bright zesty finish.

Kirkby Lonsdale, Carnforth

Established in 2009, Kirkby Lonsdale brewery are family run business whose main objective has been to bring back the art of brewing to the centre of Kirkby Lonsdale. Nine years, 33 different beers and a huge dose of hard work later, they have established two brewing sites and a tap house to showcase the brewing team and their creations. Each beer they brew is named or linked to an aspect of the town and its history.



22 Devil's Bridge IPA 5.3% IPA ♦

Named after the famous bridge on the edge of the Yorkshire Dales, this well-balanced IPA combines bright citrus and tropical fruit flavours with a gentle bitterness and crisp finish. A proper modern IPA that's full of flavour without trying too hard.

23 Imperial Dragon 8.2% IPA ♦

Dangerously drinkable Imperial IPA. Dry-hopped during racking to deliver a huge fruity hit from the aroma hops. Strong yet sublime.

Lancaster Brewery, Lancaster

Now one of the largest microbreweries in the North West, Lancaster Brewery started in a tired old shed on the outskirts of Lancaster before the brewery reached capacity in 2009. It took them two long years but they eventually made the move to new, modern premises on Lancaster Leisure Park.



24 Any Port in a Storm 4.5% SP ♦

Very special dark beer brewed with port, bringing together rich malt character and fruity depth. Notes of dark berries, dried fruit and toffee are complemented by a smooth, warming finish. Comforting, complex and lush.

25 Patriot 4% APA ♦

A bright, hop-forward American Pale Ale bursting with citrus and tropical fruit notes. Contains no red caps, conspiracy theories or election debates.

26 Pendulum 4.1% PA ♦

Season special blonde ale with hints of tropical fruits.

Little Tales Beer Co, Lancaster

Little Tales Brew Co is a small, independent brewery based in Lancaster, focused on crafting high-quality, small-batch beers with a creative edge. Known for their attention to detail and a wide variety of styles, they bring a fresh, hop-forward approach to every brew. With a growing presence in local venues, Little Tales Brew Co continues to make its mark on the craft beer scene.



27 Androids 4.5% SP ♦

A crisp, spritzzy raspberry sour bursting with juicy, jammy raspberry flavor and a refreshingly sharp, clean finish.

Milton Brewing Co, Cambridge

The Brewery has grown steadily since it was founded in 1999 and now operates pubs in Cambridge London, Peterborough and Norwich through a sister company. In 2012 the brewery moved to larger premises in the village of Waterbeach.



28 Prometheus 6% IPA ♦

A true IPA. Strong, hoppy, bitter and delicious. A blend of five hops gives this India pale ale a proper punch.

Rock the Boat Brewery, Liverpool

Est. 2015 in a 17th century wheelwright's yard. All beers racked directly from fermenter to cask for genuine secondary fermentation.



29 Dragon's Teeth 4.3% ST/PO ♦

Chocolate stout delivering a smooth, velvety texture with a flavour profile defined by dark roast malts, prominent notes of milk chocolate, and a hint of dark spirits.

30 Fab4 4.4% PA ♦

A medium bodied straw beer with fruity hop aromas, sweet fruity flavours and dry hop bitterness, finishing with light hop bitterness.

Saltire Brewery,

Shipley, West Yorkshire

Launched in 2006, Saltire is an award winning brewery based in a former Victorian power station. A mezzanine bar give visitors views of the brewing plant whilst sampling the beers.



31 Cascade 4.8% PA ♦

A proper pale ale showcasing the classic Cascade hop. Expect bright citrus aromas, led by pink grapefruit, with zesty orange and pine notes following through to a crisp, refreshing finish. Balanced malt sweetness keeps the bitterness in check, making this a hugely drinkable American-style pale.

32 Raspberry Blonde 4% SP ♦

Refreshingly smooth and delicately infused with natural raspberry flavours, this blonde ale offers a subtle fruity twist.

33 Triple Chocolate Stout 4.8% ST/PO ♦

Internationally praised and deliciously drinkable, this dark beer blends English Fuggle hops with rich chocolate decadence.

Squawk Brewing Co, Manchester

Squawk Brewing Co, founded in Manchester in 2013, initially brewed at Hand Drawn Monkey Brewery before setting up its own facility in Ardwick. Known for its hop-forward beers, the brewery expanded its reach over the years, even opening a bar, Pelican, in Manchester's Northern Quarter in 2023. However, in 2024, Squawk entered a partnership with Moorhouse's Brewery in Burnley to continue brewing its distinctive beers, ensuring the brand's future while benefiting from Moorhouse's established brewing infrastructure.



34 Mariana 5.3% PA ♦

Tropical dank hazy pale ale bursting with juicy pineapple, zesty lime and a helping of passionfruit goodness from the Citra hops. El Dorado hops pile on the tropical vibes with flavours of stone fruit.

35 Pavo 3.8% PA ♦

Classic cask pale, Pavo is balanced and deeply drinkable. Delicately straw coloured and dry hopped with Mosaic for a fruity tropical taste and aroma.

Titanic Brewery,

Stoke On Trent, Staffs

Titanic Brewery was founded in Burslem, Stoke-on-Trent in 1985. In Etruria, just down the road, Captain Edward John Smith was born. It is in honor of him that the brewery was named. From humble beginnings Titanic Brewery has grown to produce in excess of 2.3 million pints of fine ale every year.

36 Plum Porter 4.9% SP ♦

Back again. Every festival we wonder whether we should give something else a chance, and every festival this beer flies out faster than almost anything else on the bar. Rich, smooth and packed with juicy plum flavour. You know you love it.

**Weekend Project Brewery, weekend project
Knutsford, Cheshire**

Part of The Brewing Collective alongside Shindigger and Mobberley Brewhouse, Weekend Project are a Knutsford-based brewery focused on modern, hop-forward beers brewed with precision and consistency. Taking a clean, contemporary approach, they produce fresh, expressive beers that showcase quality ingredients and a strong understanding of modern styles.

37 Karaoke 4.2% PA ♦

Soft, orangey, hoppy pale ale with saturated flavour and low bitterness. Amarillo hops deliver a fragrant mix of floral citrus layered with subtle peach and nectarine. Gluten free.

38 Sandwood Bay 5% ST/PO ♦

Dry stout packed with specialty roast malt for the delicious dark, roasty flavour with a hefty dry hop of UK hops, Phoenix and Goldings.

Wild Craft Brewery, Norwich

Great tasting beer, brewed with passion and pride since 1981.

Named in honour of Parson James Woodforde, an 18th Century clergyman who wrote lovingly in his diaries of a love for good food and great beer, our story starts in the 1960's during the new-wave revolution of home brewers creating authentic flavours and crafting their own beers.

39 Wild Bill Hiccup 4.5% BI ♦

Smooth, balanced and easy-drinking with a satisfying malt backbone. No gimmicks, no nonsense. Just a beautifully balanced best bitter that does exactly what it says on the tin.

40 Wild Norfolk 4.2% IPA ♦

Fresh citrus leads the way with notes of pineapple and grapefruit, layered with subtle tropical fruit from the Azacca. Centennial and Cascade bring a classic citrus backbone, adding brightness and a gentle bitterness that keeps everything clean and refreshing. Vibrant, balanced and incredibly drinkable.

Genuine, imported wheat beer brewed in the heart of Bavaria. Made with mineral water, locally sourced barley, wheat and Hallertau Hops, Hofmeister Weisse pours thick and velvety. Its aroma bursts with ripe banana and vanilla, all backed by a bready, brioche note. Notes of lemon drizzle cake are off set by a refreshing hint of bitterness - all carried on a rich body that feels like it turns to cream on your tongue.

2 Lilley's Rhubarb 4% Fruit

Expertly blended our crisp Somerset cider and tangy rhubarb to make this a real taste sensation. Sweet and full of rhubarb flavour with a tart edge. Another festival favourite it would be unfair for us to deprive you of.



3 Lilley's Strawberry 4% Fruit

A sweet berry burst which compliments the refreshing bite of apple in this moreish, highly juicy cider.



4 Lilley's Passionfruit Martini 3.4% Speciality

A crowd-pleasing combo of vanilla and passionfruit with a hint of lime mixed with crisp Somerset cider. The hint of lime cuts through the sweetness of the passionfruit leaving you with subtle aromas and taste of vanilla.



5 Snails Bank Pineapple & Pink Grapefruit 4% Fruit

Blends sweet, smooth pineapple with the sharp tang of pink grapefruit to create a highly drinkable, summery English cider.



6 Pulp Berry Lime Blitz 3.4% Fruit

Very light brown in colour with oak and apples in aroma. Packed full of rich apple flavours that provide a dry tannic aftertaste.



7 Thistly Cross Whisky Cask 6.7% Speciality

The perfect marriage between Scottish methods and Scotland's favourite craft cider. They use single malt scotch whisky casks to give their cider its warming notes of oak, vanilla and honey.



8 Dorset Nectar Sweet Maiden 4.2% Sweet

A smooth farmhouse sweet cider blend, ripe with natural sweetness & intriguing velvety finish British Champion Farmhouse Cider Cup winner 2017.



9 Flatler Original 5.5% Medium Dry

It's cloudy, it's cyder and it bites! Slightly cloudy in character, it is a young, light, tremendously fruity and refreshing cyder with a distinctive bite.
