REAL ALE LIST



Coley's Brewery, Salford

Coley's is a new brewery which started up in 2025 in Eccles, Manchester. They produce a wide range of beer styles and are passionate about the survival of cask ale and keeping real ale relevant. They specialise in modern cask beer and aim to produce full flavoured and honest beers.



1 Bitter 4% BI ♦

Comprising six different malts, Coley's best bitter provides a malt complexity that bursts with caramelised nuts, dried fruits and, with a charge of First Gold hops, a bittersweet marmalade finish.



2 Cloudy Little Pale 3.4% PA ♦

A low ABV pale packing a high dose of juicy hops. Built on a base of oats, wheat and low colour barley, this hazy pale is then packed with Dolcita and Idaho 7 hops leaving a trail of fleshy mango, sweet pineapple and a slight lime tang. If you're taking it easy at this festival, this is the one to chill with.



3 Pub Ale 3.9% PA ♦

Drawing inspiration from some of the finest ales to ever come out of Manchester, Coley's Pub Ale is a modern take on a pub classic. Soft with a bed of oats and wheat and hopped with a variety of hedgerow English hops. Expect a smooth, creamy and blackcurrant-led moreish pale ale.

4 Stout 4.5% ST/PO ♦

This robust stout is labelled so due to its uncompromising approach to roasted malts. Bringing strong flavours of extra dark chocolate, intense espresso and a slight charred smokiness, this stout is then backed up by subtle toasted nuttiness and sticky treacle. This is joined by a small charge of English hop Phoenix, which brings low levels of bitterness, a little more chocolate and a touch of molasses.



5 West 5.2% PA ♦

Hopped with Cascade, Columbus & Simcoe this West Coast Pale oozes with pine, bitter grapefruit, juicy tangerine rind and zesty citrus peel. The inclusion of Vienna, Caramalt and a careful blend of differently kilned pale malts, gives this beer a beautiful golden orange glow topped off with a packed off-white foamy head.



6 XPA 3.8% PA ♦

A dry and low colour Extra Pale Ale with Comet, Amarillo & Cascade hops. Made with generous additions of wheat and oat, this beer holds a creamy mouthfeel which balances perfectly with that quintessential dry finish expected from an XPA. Pouring a beautiful straw yellow, our XPA offers slight dankness alongside apricot, grapefruit & citrus resulting in a perfectly refreshing flavour profile.



7 Coley's X Weekend Project - Black IPA 5.2% IPA ♦

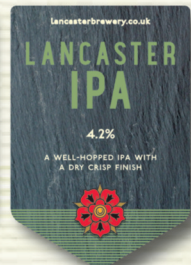
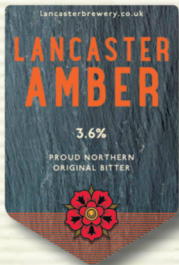
One half of a collab concept with Weekend Project. Made with plenty of oats and wheat to promote mouthfeel, it's then hopped with Strata T90 and Strata CGX so expect plenty of punchy strawberry, grapefruit and cannabis notes, cutting through the subtle tobacco from the cold-steeped dark malts.

Part of The Brewing Collective alongside Shindigger and Mobberley Brewhouse, Weekend Project are a Knutsford-based brewery focused on modern, hop-forward beers brewed with precision and consistency. Taking a clean, contemporary approach, they produce fresh, expressive beers that showcase quality ingredients and a strong understanding of modern styles.



8 Weekend Project X Coley's - White IPA 5.2% IPA ♦

One half of a collab concept with Weekend Project. Made with 50% wheat in the mash, this pillowy soft IPA is hopped throughout with fresh Galaxy T90s. Expect passionfruit upon passionfruit with a touch of juicy peach.



9 Afternoon in Chico 5.2% APA ♦

Weekend Project's love for beers born on the Pacific runs deep. Channeling those classic roots with vibrant citrus and pine notes from Citra, Simcoe, Centennial & Cascade hops. Crisp & refreshingly bitter.



10 Buttermere 4.8% PA ♦

A delicious cask pale, liberally hopped with Nectaron, Galaxy & Dolcita - serves hazy with loads of tropical & stone fruit aromas.



11 Karaoke 4.2% PA ♦

Soft, orangey, hoppy pale ale with saturated flavour and low bitterness. Amarillo hops deliver a fragrant mix of floral citrus layered with subtle peach and nectarine. **Gluten free.**



12 Rockport 3.9% PA ♦

A now classic British interpretation of an American style pale ale - Amarillo & Citra aroma hops are at the core - light bodied with a bitterness that is all about drinkability.



13 Sandwood Bay 5% ST/PO ♦

Dry stout packed with specialty roast malt for the delicious dark, roasty flavour with a hefty dry hop of U.K. hops, Phoenix & Goldings



14 The Flash 4% PA ♦

A hazy pale with the classic staples US Citra & Mosaic that provides a dank, hoppy aroma with a soft oaty finish

4T's have their own brewery tap, The Tavern where they have 8 handpulls with between 6 and 8 ever changing beers on all week long. The majority of their guest ales come from swaps with breweries nationwide

15 Chocolate and Fudge Stout Detectives 5% SP ♦

Moreish English stout with long-lasting chocolate fudge aroma.

16 Elvis Peachley 4.6% SP ♦

Peach India pale ale. Velvety smooth peach aromas. Take my hand, take my whole life too. I can't help falling in love with Elvis Peachley.

17 Mango Fever 4.6% SP ♦

Mango India pale ale. American hops create intense bittering and amazing bursts of citrus and grapefruit



aromas, with the constant punch of bitterness surrounding the mouthful. A proper full-on mango explosion.

Allsops Brewery, Sheffield

An independent brewery founded in 1996 who blend creativity and innovation with heritage and tradition, which reflects across their beers. Their house style could typically be described as pale and hoppy, but that's not all they can do. As the beer world has evolved so have they, covering a wide range of styles and continually pushing the boundaries of what can be created.

18 India Pale Ale 5% IPA ♦

Samuel Allsopp was the first to perfect Burton-brewed India Pale Ale. Some 200 years later, Allsopp & Sons invite you to savour this faithful recreation of the complex, beguiling, original Burton IPA.



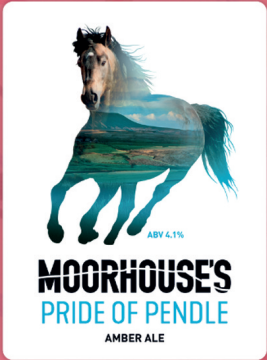

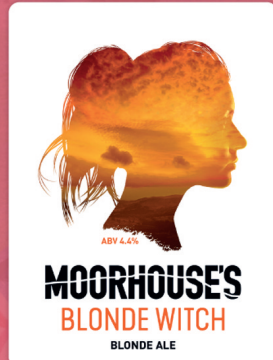

Alnwick Brewery, Northumberland



Brewing started in the 1860s in the centre of Alnwick, the capital of Northumberland. The brewery was acquired in 1978 by Scottish brewer Dryboroughs, who closed it in 1986, but relaunched in 2003 with the assistance of the Duchess of Northumberland. Beers are also brewed under the Holy Island name. More than 50 outlets are supplied in the north of England.

19 Amber 3.8% BI ♦

Malty backbone, biscuit body and a refreshing citrus aftertaste with a dry hop character.

20 Blonde Star 4.1% PA ♦

Crisp and fresh, light in body but certainly not in flavour. Brimful of lemon, grapefruit, and passion fruit. Refreshing and bready, with a bright finish. Everybody needs a bosom for a pillow.

21 NEIPA 5% IPA ♦

Hazy New England IPA. Hop-forward and juicy.

Anarchy Brew Co,

Newcastle, Tyneside



Anarchy started life back in 2012 in Morpeth, Northumberland. One name changed later and they settled on Anarchy Brew Co and began brewing their core beer, packed with flavor that they still make today. In October 2012, they moved to new digs in Newcastle.

22 Sinistar 4.0% DARK ♦

Dark Ale. Aromas of roast coffee and sweet pastry and gentle bitterness with lingering citrus finish.

23 Spring Pale 4.1% PA ♦

Beautiful seasonal special. Floral blonde beer.

Big Bog Brewery, Liverpool



Originally based in North Wales, Big Bog Brewery moved to South Liverpool before being reborn in Little Crosby, now under the care of new owner Tom, who also runs Rock The Boat Brewery. Known for their well-crafted beers, Big Bog continues to champion quality brews with a strong sense of tradition

24 Hinkypunk 4.1% APA ♦

A well-hopped beer with a secret blend of no less than seven American hop varieties. Intense citrus notes and its incredibly pale colour make this a really unique ale.

Cheviot Brewery, Northumberland



Cheviot Brewery is a micro brewery on the Ford & Etal Estate in North Northumberland producing traditional cask and bottled ale. Offering brewery tours and tastings at our Cheviot Tap onsite tap bar and an onsite Glamping and self catering accommodation. Brewing with the best ingredients and creating ales inspired by the history and landscape of North Northumberland.

25 Harbour Wall 4.2% PA ♦

Refreshingly zesty, easy drinking, light session pale ale, with floral, tropical fruit and pine notes.

Colbier Brew Co, Liverpool



Established in 2024 by Mike Corbett, Stuart Rumble and Vik Williams, who, collectively carry over a decade of experience gleaned from their respective roles in various local craft beer bars and breweries.

Forging a bond through their shared passion for music, they embrace a philosophy that mirrors musicology - to acknowledge rules while daring to break them.

Equalising balance, simplicity, and quality, they are producing the very styles that ignited their brewing journey. Experimenting on a pilot kit and fine-tuning core recipes on a larger 20HL kit, to consistently deliver Proper Sound Beers from the beat of Liverpool.

26 Arpeggio 4.9% IPA ♦

Red Rye IPA with a deep amber-red colour and bold, layered malt complexity. Spicy rye malt takes centre stage, with a light peppery spice and hints of caramel and toasted grain. Amarillo and Centennial hops bring bright citrus and floral notes, cutting through the malt richness with a zesty bitterness. Deep in flavour, but crisp, and slightly dry on the finish, perfect for those seeking a flavourful twist on a classic IPA.

27 Nocturne 4.5% STPO ♦

Expect biscuity, chocolatey, lightly roasted goodness from Nocturne, this classic English oatmeal stout. Textured and silky smooth on the mouthfeel thanks to the addition of oats, with a subtle sweet hint of orange – it's a good job that this brew comes in at just 4.5%, as it's especially moreish.

28 Skirl 5% IPA ♦

Collab with Edinburgh-based Barney's Beers. Malt-forward base, mixing heritage and Scottish malt, fermented using a Scottish yeast strain from Jasper Yeast. A bitter, piney and resinous IPA, with a grassy complexity.

Darwin Brewery, North Shields



Darwin Brewery is focused on making high quality cask ales, with great flavour and aroma. The brewery has a core range of 6 beers and monthly one-off or seasonal products. Their beer is mainly sold to outlets in the North East, but appears more regularly around the UK with increased work with distributors. Darwin Brewery was established in Sunderland in 1994.

29 Beagle Blonde 4.1% PA ♦

Golden blonde ale. Light and refreshing, hopped with Willamette for a balanced citrus finish.

30 Evolution 4.0% BI ♦

Copper coloured malty bitter. Gently hopped to complement a grain bill which includes amber and crystal malts.



First&Last Brewery, Bellingham

First & Last was established in 2016 by Red Kellie, a founder member of Stu Brew in Newcastle upon Tyne. Upgraded to a five-barrel plant in 2018, they relocated eight miles up the road to Bellingham in 2022 with further expansion to a 10bbl plant plus the addition of a shop and taproom. Outlets in Northumberland, Tyne and Wear and the Scottish Borders are supplied.

**31 North Star 3.4% PA**

Easy drinking pale ale brewed with Strata & Simcoe hops.

32 Reiver 4.2% BI

A classic best bitter with a fruity aroma and flavour. Brewed with 5 British malts and Fuggles and East Kent Goldings hops.

Five Points Brewing, London

The Five Points Brewing Company is an independent brewery based in Hackney, London, brewing with a commitment to quality and the community since 2013. In May of 2023, we opened up The Five Points Courtyard—an expansive outdoor space to enjoy incredible drinks and food in an ideal East London location. We celebrated Ten Years of Five Points in 2023, and are looking ahead to what the next ten years will bring, as we continue to evolve as an independently-owned brewery and champion better ways of working and living while making some of the UK's best-loved beers.

**33 Pale 4.4% PA**

Five Points Pale is a fresh, zesty, aromatic pale ale brewed with malted barley, a little wheat, and Amarillo, Cascade and Citra hops from the West Coast of the USA. Easy drinking with citrus and pine notes.

34 Railway Porter 4.8% STPO

A classic, robust London style porter - with a twist. Smooth and full-bodied, bursting with aromas of dark, bitter chocolate, and roasted coffee. Brewed with 100% British ingredients, including Goldings from Hukins Hops, and an array of seven different malts.

Frome Brewing Co, Frome

It all started with a teenager and a home brew kit in an airing cupboard. His friends loved the results and demand was up. Suddenly, the airing cupboard wasn't big enough anymore... Our hero begged and borrowed and eventually found a derelict pub in Frome with a tiny bit of brewing space.

That derelict pub wasn't big enough anymore... Moving into shiny new premises meant the one-man band became the Frome Brewing Company. Still experimenting, still pouring heart and soul into every brew.

35 Bootleg Beer 4.2% PA

Brewed with extra pale malt, oats, and wheat, this Session IPA is packed with bright American hops and infused with 20kg of real mango for a juicy lift. Expect vibrant flavours of mango, pineapple, and orange zest, balanced by a smooth pale body and a clean, easy-drinking finish.

**36 Funky Monkey 4% PA**

Multi-award winning copper-coloured summer ale with fruity flavours and aromas. A dry finish with developing bitterness and an undertone of citrus fruit.

37 Krush 4.1% APA

Dry hopping with Krush, Casade, Citra and Cashmere adds notes of white peach, melon, citrus and tropical fruit. Smooth, gently creamy with balanced bitterness. Very refreshing.

38 Taiheke 4.3% PA

Taiheke and Rakau are both products of New Zealand and give this delicious beer a bouquet of lime, melon and lychee on the nose, which then transfers to the flavour before a delightfully crisp biscuity mid-palate note acts as a bridge to the dry and bittersweet finish.

George Samuel Brewery,

Shildon

A modern traditional brewery focused on quality and consistency, George Samuel brew using whole hop flowers and Maris Otter malt to create classic, well-balanced ales. Rooted in traditional methods but with a contemporary approach, their beers deliver familiar styles done properly.

**39 Travelling Light 4.5% IPA**

Session IPA, yes indeedly.

Hadrian Border Brewery,

Newburn, Newcastle-upon Tyne

Based in Newburn near Newcastle-upon-Tyne, using a 40-barrel plant, the brewery can produce up to 200 barrels per week. Beer is delivered directly to the area between Edinburgh, North Yorkshire, Carlisle and the East Coast, and is also available nationally through wholesalers. A three-barrel plant is used for experimental craft brews. One pub is run - the Station East, Gateshead.

**40 Secret Kingdom 4.3% RA**

Dark, rich and full-bodied slightly roasted with a malty palate ending with a pleasant bitterness.

Harvey's Brewery, Sussex

Harvey's Brewery is one of the most respected traditional breweries in the country, brewing in Lewes since 1790. Family-owned and fiercely independent, they are known for their uncompromising approach to quality, using their own yeast strain and time-honoured methods. Expect proper, characterful ales with depth, balance and a real sense of heritage.

**41 Old Ale 4.3% TA**

Soft and full-bodied, with hints of dried fruits and dates. Rich, dark and warming.



42 Sussex Best 4% BI ◆

Renowned, award-winning English bitter brewed in Lewes using local hops, Sussex water, and a 60-year-old yeast strain. This deep amber ale is known for its balanced, hoppy flavour with hints of caramel and fruit, offering an authentic taste of Sussex heritage.

Kirkby Lonsdale, Kirkby Lonsdale

Established in 2009, a family run business who's main objective has been to bring back the art of brewing to the centre of Kirkby Lonsdale. Nine years, 33 different beers and a huge dose of hard work later they have established two brewing sites and a tap house to showcase their brewing team and their creations.

43 Crafty Mild 3.6% MI ◆

A modern take on the traditional mild. Brewed with rich, dark malts and delicately hopped for a very moreish beer.

44 Devil's Bridge IPA 5.2% IPA ◆

Citrusy IPA and slightly floral finishing with bitter notes for a clean, crisp taste.

45 Equinox 4% PA ◆

An experimental pale ale. That's literally all we've been told about this one! Give it a go and let us know.

Kirkstall Brewery, Leeds

Founded in 2011, Kirkstall Brewery have built a reputation for brewing clean, hop-forward beers with precision and consistency. Inspired by both traditional British styles and modern craft influences, their range covers everything from easy-drinking pales to more robust, flavoured brews, all produced to an exceptionally high standard

46 Black Band 5.5% ST/PO ◆

A full bodied yet beautifully smooth dark porter. Perfectly balanced flavours of chocolate and coffee enhanced by the mild herbal hop character. Deliciously dark.

47 Dissolution 5% IPA ◆

Brewed in memory of the dissolution of Kirkstall Abbey by Henry VIII, in 1539 AD, and the disbanding of the Abbey's Cistercian order. This is a classic India Pale Ale, with a resolute hoppy kick and lasting citrus finish. As history teaches us, the best way to honour 16th-century upheaval is with a well-balanced, mid-strength ale.

48 Three Swords 4.5% PA ◆

Three American hop varieties are used in abundance to deliver a crisp, aromatic pale ale with clean and refreshing citrus-fruit flavours.

Lancaster Brewery, Lancaster

One of the largest microbreweries in the North West. They started in a tired old shed on the outskirts of Lancaster before the brewery reached capacity in 2009. It took them two long years but they eventually made the move to new, modern premises on Lancaster Leisure Park.

49 Black 4.5% ST/PO ◆

Gold Medal winner SIBA Awards 2025. Classic traditional stout. Complex taste with a rich and full body. Crisp with a full bouquet of spices, fruit and floral aromas. Black is a stout for the true connoisseur.

50 Citra 4.2% PA ◆

Big fruity pale ale hopped with Citra with a refreshing mango aftertaste.

51 Kaleidoscope 4.6% PA ◆

A seasonal special from Lancaster. Very pale ale with a bright, hoppy finish.

52 Session Pale 3.4% PA ◆

Hoppy gluten free pale ale. Don't let its strength fool you; this is a highly drinkable beer.

53 Wooky Juice 4.3% PA ◆

Tropical, hazy, spicy pale ale. Many Wookys were juiced in the creation of this beer.

Little Tales Beer Co, Lancaster

Little Tales Brew Co is a small, independent brewery based in Lancaster, focused on crafting high-quality, small-batch beers with a creative edge. Known for their attention to detail and a wide variety of styles, they bring a fresh, hop-forward approach to every brew. With a growing presence in local venues, Little Tales Brew Co continues to make its mark on the craft beer scene.

54 Emperor 3.8% PA ◆

A commanding light golden ale with hints of grapefruit, mango and lemon.

55 Ratio 4.2% PA ◆

Golden ale with red fruit and citrus zest.

Mobberley Brew House,

Cheshire

Situated in an idyllic location in a small village in Cheshire, Mobberley produce a growing range of craft beers. Inspiration for their beers is drawn from the sprawling countryside that surrounds the brewery.

56 American Red 4.8% RA ◆

A super hoppy tribute to the classic American red ale, hopped with US Cascade and Mosaic, dry with aromatic malt flavour, robust and bitter finish.

More Mobberley Beers 



Mobberley Beers contd,**57 Choc Stout 4.6% STPO ♦**

Rich, smooth and roasty, this traditional stout has big notes of chocolate, a soft body from the flaked malted oats and hints of sweet caramel on the finish. Delightful.

58 Heritage IPA 5.2% IPA ♦

A big, bright old-school IPA which John on Untapped describes as "Good". We think it's better than that. Head to the bar and make your own mind up.

Moorhouse's Brewery,

Burnley, Lancs

Moorhouse's is an independent brewery founded in 1865, starting life as a producer of mineral waters and low-alcohol beers known as hop bitters. Its first produced cask ales in 1978. At the heart of what Moorhouse's do is their state of the art brewery which combines their brewers' craft with the innovation and new techniques of today. Moorhouse's are beer lovers with discerning standards and every pint is brewed to perfection, for you to enjoy.

59 Blonde Witch 4.4% PA ♦

A punchy, full-bodied blonde ale with a distinct fruit taste and citrus hop finish.

60 Bloomin' 'Eck 4.1% PA ♦

Extra pale Spring ale single-hopped with British Godiva hops for fruity and herbal notes.

61 Pride of Pendle 4.1% BI ♦

RedWillow Brewery Macclesfield

Established in 2010 by homebrewer Toby McKenzie and his wife Caroline. In 2015 brewing moved to a larger, purpose-built unit on the same site. The award-winning beers are distributed nationwide and are available from the brewery's own RedWillow bars in Macclesfield and Buxton.

63 Dreamless 4.4% PA ♦

A hazy New England IPA designed to bring a smile to your face. Lashings of Citra, Mosaic and Idaho 7 create a cloudburst of tropical fruit salad flavours that assail your senses.

64 F232 – Dreaming of Strata**4.4% PA ♦**

A soft, hazy session NEIPA bursting with Strata, Riwaka and Simcoe. Juicy passionfruit, ripe mango and zesty citrus glide dreamily over a pillowy body, finishing fresh, bright and effortlessly drinkable.

65 Feckless 4.1% BI ♦

Classic British bitter. Rich toffee and malt balanced with the subtle flavours of Challenger, Goldings and Target hops. Multi-award winning.

66 Pennyless 8.4% Barley Wine ♦

Deep ruby hues and decadent layers of chocolate, dates, figs and raisins define this indulgent Pastry Barley Wine. Smooth, full-bodied and warming.

Rigg & Furrow Brewery

Northumberland



An authentic farmhouse brewery. Giving a new lease of life to an old milking parlour, where they now create new takes on Farmhouse beers - beers originally brewed for thirsty farm workers. Brewing by hand, this independent, family run brewery creates exciting, innovative, fermentation focused beers.

67 Run Hop Run 4.2% IPA ♦

Liverpool



Est. 2015 in a 17th century wheelwright's yard.

All beers racked directly from fermenter to cask for genuine secondary fermentation.

68 Dragon's Teeth 4.3% STPO ♦

Chocolate stout with a smooth velvet texture with a complexity of flavours from the combined dark English malted barley. Aromas of chocolate malt and vanilla.

69 Fab Four 4.4% PA ♦

A medium-bodied straw IPA with fruity hop aromas, sweet fruity flavours and dry hop bitterness, finishing with light hop bitterness. Brewed in memory of a little-known Liverpool four piece known as 'The Beatles'. *Editor's note - honestly never heard of 'em.*



Shindigger Brewing Co,

Manchester



Shindigger are shadow brewers. Shadow brewing means they develop their own recipes on their pilot kit at their HQ in Manchester. Once the recipe is finalised, the beer is brewed in commercial batches on one of their two partner breweries kits. Shindigger was launched with a £10000 government loan for young entrepreneurs. 8 years on they have released over 40 beers, lead a team of 12 people and brew 1.4 million pints per annum.

70 Pale 4.5% PA ◆

Clean and crisp pale with a burst of orange from the lead hop Amarillo. West Coast Pale is our homage to the West Coast styles that dawned a new era in world brewing and inspired us to start brewing.

71 Red Dead 4.4% RA ◆

An American red ale bursting with earthy notes of berries and redcurrant.

72 Space Cadet 4.5% PA ◆

Amarillo lift-off with a deep under-thrust of Cascade powers this cosmic pint skyward unto the infinite black hole suction of your mouth - suspending a clean orbit of pine and citrus - crisp as light, gone in a moment. Or something.

Squawk Brewing Co, Manchester

Squawk Brewing Co, founded in Manchester in 2013, initially brewed at Hand Drawn Monkey Brewery before setting up its own facility in Ardwick. Known for its hop-forward beers, the brewery expanded its reach over the years, even opening a bar, Pelican, in Manchester's Northern Quarter in 2023. However, in 2024, Squawk entered a partnership with Moorhouse's Brewery in Burnley to continue brewing its distinctive beers, ensuring the brand's future while benefiting from Moorhouse's established brewing infrastructure.

**73 Kiwi 5% IPA** ◆

NZ IPA built on a traditional cask IPA malt base to give a gentle biscuit sweetness and a warm golden hue. This one bursts with bright lime zest, crushed gooseberry, passion fruit and tropical citrus aromas.

74 Pavo 3.8% PA ◆

Delicately straw coloured and dry hopped with Mosaic for a fruity tropical taste and aroma. Balanced and deeply drinkable.

Strawberry Fields Brewery,

Liverpool



Relatively new on the scene, Strawberry Fields Brewery was borne out of true love for the golden, magical drink. Their exceptionally tasty craft beers are locally produced and you may recognise a few of their beer names too. Brewed in the same premises as their sister brewery, Big Bog

75 Forever 4% APA ◆

A true American Pale Ale made with 6 row American barley malt and oodles of American Chinook and Cascade hops, and dry hopped too. A golden beer with a good bitterness and a refreshing citrus fruit taste.

Three Brothers Brewery,

Stockton on Seas



Three Brothers is a family run brewery in County Durham, who turned an empty shell industrial unit into a modern and efficient brewery capable of producing 7500 pints per week. It is the blend of passion, experience, innovation and style that makes the beer they produce competitively tasty, refreshingly different and always of the highest quality.

76 Bitter Ex 3.7% BI ◆

A traditional malty light amber ale with notes of caramel and toffee and a refreshing bitter finish.

77 New Day IPA 4.1% IPA ◆

A punchy cask IPA packed with four big American hops combining the full-force hoppy flavour you expect from an IPA. Power!

Titanic Brewery,

Stoke On Trent, Staffs



Titanic Brewery was founded in Burslem, Stoke-on-Trent in 1985. In Etruria, just down the road, Captain Edward John Smith was born. It is in honor of him that the brewery was named. From humble beginnings Titanic Brewery has grown to produce in excess of 2.3 million pints of fine ale every year.

78 Cappuccino Stout 4.5% SP ◆

A smooth, roasted stout with strong notes of coffee throughout, and a lingering sweet finish

79 Plum Porter 4.9% SP ◆

A well-rounded speciality porter with a sweet, fruity nose. Notes of plum and other stone fruits are present throughout, balanced against a delicate blend of classic hops

Three Kings Brewery,

North Shields

Today the brewery proudly produces 10 regular ales and many seasonal and special ales which are sold to pubs and bottle outlets throughout the South East of England & East Anglia

National award-winning American Pale Ale exploding with American hops. This is a well balanced beer with plenty of aroma and flavour..

83 Ravening Wolf 5.9% IPA ♦

Strong, sexy New Zealand pale. Toasted biscuit and rye malt flavours support a pine lemon hop crispness with a hint of vanilla.

Wear Beer, Sunderland

Sunderland's newest microbrewery Wear Beer is now fully operational and brewing from the basement of The Ship Isis, with a focus on north east produce. They have 4 core beers available at venues around the city. Head brewer and Brew Lab alumnus Julio Romero Johnson is planning more experimental beers in the future with a view to expanding the range.



84 Dry Irish 4.5% ST/PO ♦

Traditional Irish stout. As dry as something wet can be.

XT Brewing Company,

Long Crendon, Bucks



XT Brewing Company produces a wide range of eXTremely tasty craft beers from their brewery at Notley Farm in the village of Long Crendon, near Oxford. The brewery was created by Russ and Gareth in 2011 using a custom, all British built 18-barrel brew house. They brew all their own real ales for cask, keg and bottles.

85 Wallingford East India Pale Ale 4.6% IPA ♦

Dead Brewer's Society is based at XT Brewing Co, focusing on beers from a bygone era. This one is from Wallingford Brewery and is an IPA last brewed in 1923 - way before the bomb landed in the very place you're stood!

86 Hop Kitty 3.9% PA ♦

Packed with quantities of Citra and Cascade hops, Hop Kitty is bursting with intense tropical and citrus flavours. Just like every crazy cat person, you'll find it hard to stop at one.

87 Moonrat 4.6% PA ♦

Well balanced golden pale, single malt and single hopped. Tropical fruit aromas and citrus flavours throughout leaving you with a refreshing caramel aftertaste.

88 Tarka 4.6% IPA ♦

A pale IPA brewed with British hops - Admiral, Challenger, Goldings and Mystic - to give notes of blackcurrant, passionfruit and orange, as well as resin and herb flavours.

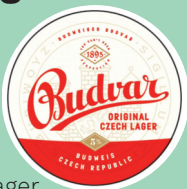

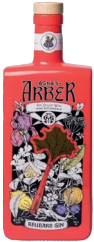

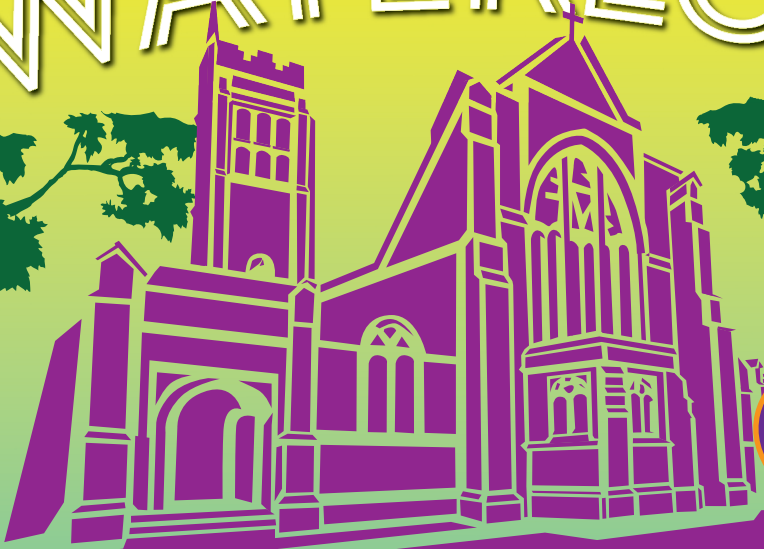
